# Would for hypothesising

We use *would* + infinitive to talk about hypothetical situations.

What would it be like?

The journey would be exciting.

Only rich people would go.

#### **Noun phrases**

Tourists would love it.

Tourists with lots of money would love it.

Tourists looking for something new would love it.

Tourists looking for a different type of holiday would love it.

Tourists looking for a room with a really special view would love it.

#### Verb patterns

#### verb + noun

The verbs consider, organise and investigate can be followed by a noun.

We are **considering** a different **option**.

They are organising a holiday.

The company is investigating a new drug.

#### verb + infinitive with to

The verb intend is followed by an infinitive.

He intends to open a restaurant.

## verb + infinitive with to + noun

The *verbs prepare, plan, decide* and *arrange* can be followed by an infinitive and then a noun.

NASA is preparing to send a man to Mars.

We are planning to save money.

They have decided to sell their car.

We have arranged to have lunch in a restaurant.
