#### Surprise and disbelief

I don't believe it!  
It's unbelievable!  
It's amazing!  
It can't be true!  
It's incredible!

#### Expressing no surprise

That doesn't surprise me.  
I'm not surprised.  
No wonder.  
I can believe it.

#### "Bad luck" superstitions

to walk under a ladder  
the number 13  
to see a black cat  
to see the full moon through a window

### GRAMMAR

#### Regular past tense

ask- asked  
decide – decided  
die – died  
flash – flashed  
look - looked  
pull – pulled  
scratch – scratched  
start – started

#### Irregular past tense

be – was/were  
buy – bought  
come – came  
get – got  
have – had  
hear – heard  
stand – stood  
think – thought  
wake up – woke up  
win – won

#### Past tense negative

The reporters **didn't believe** him.  
Bruce **didn't win** a car.

#### So + adjective + *that*

She was **so** hungry **that** she ate five hamburgers.  
He was **so** tired **that** he went to sleep.  
She was **so** fast **that** she won the race.

That's amazing!

Many happy returns. (for a birthday)

### **Responding to bad news**

Better luck next time.

I'm really very sorry.

I hope you get well soon.

That's bad news.
